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The examination consists of an anterior occlusal radiograph of the maxillae, a periapical radiograph of the anterior maxilla and an iCAT<sup>®</sup> cone-beam computed tomographic examination extending from the floors of the orbits to the body of the mandible. Axial and reconstructed sagittal and coronal sections are reviewed.

There is a single supernumerary tooth in the maxillary midline. The tooth is also a dens invaginatus. The presence and eruption of this supernumerary tooth has caused rotation and distal displacement of the developing 1.1 crown. The position of the developing tooth 2.1 appears unaffected.

The borders of the depicted paranasal sinuses are intact. There is mucosal thickening in the left maxillary sinus. This appearance is consistent with sinusitis.

The generalized bone pattern and jaw morphology are within the range of normal.

**Interpretation:** 1. Erupting maxillary midline dens invaginatus supernumerary tooth.  
2. Left maxillary sinusitis.
